Dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

It is with great pleasure that we are able to announce that the Reverend Dr Steven Benford has been nominated by the Diocese of Dunedin to be the next Bishop of Dunedin. This nomination has now been confirmed by the General Synod of the Anglican Church in Aotearoa, New Zealand and Polynesia.

We look forward to welcoming Dr Benford together with his wife Lorraine back to New Zealand as Steven takes up this important responsibility in our Church.

Dr Benford is currently the Vicar of St Joseph the Worker, Northolt in the Diocese of London. He had previously served as the Vicar of St Luke's in the city of York, a post he combined with working part time as an anaesthetist in a city hospital there. From 1990 to 1995 Dr Benford worked as a GP in Oamaru and one day a week in Dunedin Hospital as an anaesthetist. Lorraine was born in Dunedin and brought up in Gore.

Rev Dr Steven Benford's ordination as Bishop of Dunedin will take place in St Paul's Cathedral Church, Dunedin, in September 2017.

We give thanks to God for the careful process of discernment of the Electoral College of the Diocese of Dunedin and assure Steven and Lorraine of our support and prayers over the weeks to come. An announcement of a date for the Episcopal Ordination of the next Bishop of Dunedin will follow soon.
