- Bookings can be made via email to info@handsonhistory.co.nz (with a scanned copy of your application form attached) or print and hand your form in person at the museum front desk.
 Bookings will only be confirmed upon receipt of payment.
- NO REFUNDS, FAMILY CREDITS, STUDENT SWAPS OR DAY EXCHANGES will be made for changes or cancellations to bookings.
- Information regarding the particular workshop will be emailed once a booking is confirmed.
- Children attending need to arrive with a snack for 2 hour workshops/lunch for 4 hour workshops, a drink bottle, a hat (for any outdoor breaks) and appropriate art clothes for every workshop they attend.
- Children may be photographed for marketing purposes. Notify the museum if you do not agree to this.
- The workshops will take place at the Lakes District Museum.
